

Agreement on the Essentials and Conditions of Advanced Master's State Examination

conclude, in keeping with Art. 51 of the Civil Code, this Agreement:

I. Basis Concluding the Agreement

This Agreement may be concluded based upon a written application for Advanced Master's State Examination submitted by the Applicant to the Faculty of Pharmacy at the University of Veterinary and Pharmaceutical Sciences Brno, dated **Month Day Year** concerning the preparation and defence of Advanced Master's Thesis and sitting the Advanced Master's State examination in the field of study:

**SOCIAL PHARMACY/ PHARMACOGNOSY/ PHARMACEUTICS/ PHARMACOLOGY AND TOXICOLOGY/
PHARMACEUTICAL CHEMISTRY**

II. Subject of the Agreement and Duration of the Contractual Relationship

1. This Agreement aims to define the basic essentials and conditions of Advanced Master's State Examination for which the Applicant has applied in keeping with Art. Par. 5 of Act No. 111/1998 Coll., as amended (hereinafter “Act”) and the Advanced Master's State Examination Provisions of the Faculty of Pharmacy whose due the course and successful completion represent a necessary prerequisite for the “PharmDr” academic title to be granted to the Applicant.
2. The Applicant shall become a participant in Advanced Master's State Examination process after the conditions indicated under Art. 7 Par. 1 of the Advanced Master's State Examination Provisions have been fulfilled but **Month Day Year** at the earliest.
3. As part of the Advanced Master's State Examination process, the Applicant shall present an Advanced Master's Thesis on the following topic:

4. In keeping with Art. 8 Par. 3 of the Advanced Master's State Examination Provisions of the Faculty of Pharmacy, the Applicant has decided to make use of the following services offered by the Public University:
 - use of the Faculty of Pharmacy **facilities and information** technologies to prepare and create an Advanced Master's State Thesis under conditions identical to those of students in the pharmacy Master's programme,

- provision of a supervisor in keeping with Art. 5 of the Advanced Master's State Examination Provisions
- the following individual proposed by the Applicant or with whom the Applicant has agreed,

III. Obligations of the Contractual Parties:

1. The Public University pledges to allow the Applicant to take part in the Advanced Master's State Examination under the conditions designated by law, its internal regulations and this Agreement.
2. If the Applicant decides to accept the offer to use the facilities and information technologies at the Faculty of Pharmacy to prepare and create the Advanced Master's State Thesis, the Faculty of Pharmacy shall ensure the Applicant has been acquainted with legal and other regulations ensuring occupational safety, safety of technological equipment and the protection of health at work along with any fire-fighting or other operational regulations and specifics of the department in question.
3. The Applicant is obligated to demonstrate the fees for the Advanced Master's State Examination designated in accordance with Art. 13 of the Advanced Master's State Examination Provisions of the Faculty of Pharmacy have been paid. These fees must be paid within 14 days prior to the date on which the Advanced Master's State Examination procedure is to take place, at the latest – see Art. II/2.

Participants in the Advanced Master's State Examination process shall be governed by the internal regulations and norms of the University of Veterinary and Pharmaceutical Sciences and the Faculty of Pharmacy in force as well as by the internal regulations of the department in which the Advanced Master's Thesis is prepared in keeping with this Agreement.

IV. Other Provisions

This Agreement does not establish an employment relationship or any other labour/law relationship between the contractual parties.

V. Final Provisions

1. All amendments to this Agreement and any additions thereto must be adopted in the form of written addenda to this Agreement to which the signatures of the Applicant and the authorized representatives of the Public University have been affixed.
2. This Agreement shall become valid and effective on the date of its signature by the Applicant and an authorized representative of the Public University and is concluded for the period of time of the Advanced Master's State Examination procedure.
3. This Agreement has been prepared in three counterparts of which the Applicant shall receive one and two shall be retained by the Faculty of Pharmacy.
